

TOWN OF HARMONY
CHAPTER 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE TOWN OF HARMONY, WISCONSIN
ALCOHOL LICENSES

SECTION 1: DELINQUENT TAXES, ASSESSMENTS, ETC.

(1) Premises

No initial or renewal alcohol beverage license shall be granted for any premises located within the boundaries of the Town of Harmony for which taxes, assessments, or other claims of the Town of Harmony are delinquent and unpaid.

(2) Persons

No initial or renewal alcohol beverage license shall be granted to any person

(A) Delinquent in payment of taxes, assessments, or other claims owed to the Town of Harmony; or

(B) Delinquent in payment of a forfeiture resulting from a violation of any ordinance of the Town of Harmony.

SECTION 2: LICENSE FEES

License fees for Alcohol Beverage Licenses are hereby established as follows:

- (1) Class "A" beer – \$100.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (2) Class "B" beer – \$100.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (3) Wholesale beer – \$25.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (4) "Class A" liquor – \$400.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (5) "Class B" liquor – \$400.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.

- (6) Reserve “Class B” liquor – initial issuance fee of \$10,000.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (7) Reserve “Class B” liquor – annual license fee of \$400.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (8) “Class C” wine – \$100.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (9) Provisional Class “A” beer, Class “B” beer, “Class A” liquor, “Class B” liquor, and “Class C” wine – \$10.00 or such other fee as determined by resolution of the Town Board.
- (10) Six-month licenses – one-half the annual fee for the relevant license.
- (11) Operator’s license – \$25.00 (valid for one year).
- (12) Temporary operator’s license – \$10.00.
